Poem – Only One Mother (Explanation)



Stanza – 1. Hundreds of stars in the pretty sky,
Hundreds of shells on the shore together,
Hundreds of birds that go singing by,
Hundreds of lambs in the sunny weather.

Explanation: Here the poet tells us that you can see hundreds of stars in the sky which look so pretty with their presence and hundreds of shells can be seen together on the sea shore. Poet is also telling us that you can see hundreds of birds that go singing from one place to another and hundreds of lambs grazing on the field in the sunny weather.

Stanza – 2. Hundreds of dewdrops to greet the dawn,
Hundreds of bees in the purple clover,
Hundreds of butterflies on the lawn,
But only one mother the wide world over.

Explanation: Here the poet gave some more examples of things which can be seen in hundreds. He talks about dewdrops which can be seen early in the morning as if they had arrived there to greet the morning. He also says that you can even see hundreds of bees in the purple clover and hundreds of butterflies on the lawn but you can see only one mother in the world wide over.

<u>Central theme</u> - This poem is written by **George Cooper**. He says that there are hundreds of different things in the world but there is only one mother. Importance of mother is much more than anything in the world. For every mother her child is one of the best gifts from the God and for every child, mother is the best gift from the God.
