

CHAPTER - 6 WILD ANIMALS

What is a wild animal?

A wild animal is an animal that is wild in nature that means it are not domesticated and lives on its own. It generally lives in the forest and finds its own food and shelter.

There are many wild animals in the forest such as Lion, Tiger, Elephant, Zebra, Giraffe, Monkeys, Hippopotamus, and many more(expect these names of the animals to be listen by the students, only if they went to the zoo).



Yellow-brown hair which is called mane.


A female lion is called the lioness. It is easy to spot a lioness because she doesn't has a mane. The lion prey other animals for their food and lives in the forest. The sound of the lion is called roar or growl.





Hey! which animal is this?
Yes, this is a tiger. The tiger
belongs to the cat families
that is why they look likes a
big cat. It also has sharp
claws but a big tail. The
colour of the tiger is
yellowish- orange with black
stripes. They prey other
animals for food. The female
tiger is called the tigress.
The sound of the tiger is
called roar.

Now, which animal is this?
This is an elephant. An elephant is the biggest animal. It has a huge body and a big trunk. It has two big teeth and ears. An elephant loves to eat leaves and fruits specially banana. The sound of the elephant is called trumpet(if possible try to imitate the sound of the animals).



This is a giraffe. The giraffe is the tallest animal in the world. It has a long neck and a short tail. It has two short horns.

The giraffe loves to eat leaves and fruits.



Now, which animal is this?
Yes, this is a zebra. The colour of the zebra is white with black stripes. The zebra eats grass and leaves.

- 4) Tigers are good swimmers. They can swim in rivers or streams.




