  - **Acquired traits**- Traits that are acquired by people during lifetime  
**EX-** Likes and dislikes , habits etc.
  - **Hereditary traits**- Traits that are inherited from the parents and can be carried down to the next generation.  
**EX-** Eye colour, Shape of the nose etc.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Acquired at time of birth.</li><li>• Get from parents.</li><li>• Ex- eye color, hair color etc.</li><li>• Can be passed down from one generation to another.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Acquired during lifetime.</li><li>• Get from different people.</li><li>• Ex- habits, like etc.</li><li>• Cannot be passed down from one generation to another.</li></ul>
