Roots are high in energy value and good sources of vitamin-B group. Seeds are relatively high in Carbohydrates and Proteins. Leaves, Stems and fruits are excellent sources of minerals, vitamins, water and roughage. An intake of about 280 grams of vegetables per day is considered essential for maintenance of good health.
