- 1. 'Selfie' is defined as a photograph that one has taken of oneself, typically taken with a smart phone or web cam and shared via social media. But because it seems to be all the rage to be negative about popular things, many people have labelled selfie -taking as negative. Teenagers with an affinity for taking pictures of themselves are considered to be 'self-absorbed', or it is suggested that perhaps they spend too much time wallowing in their own narcissism.

They allow you to put yourself 'out there' and let the world know that you exist. Andrea Letamendi, a clinical psychologist and research fellow at UCLA, noted in a study and was quoted in a Time magazine article as saying, "Self-captured image allow young adults and teens to express their mood states and share important experiences."
- 4. Selfies are sometimes more than just trying to look pretty. They can be about empowering yourself and sharing that feeling with others.
