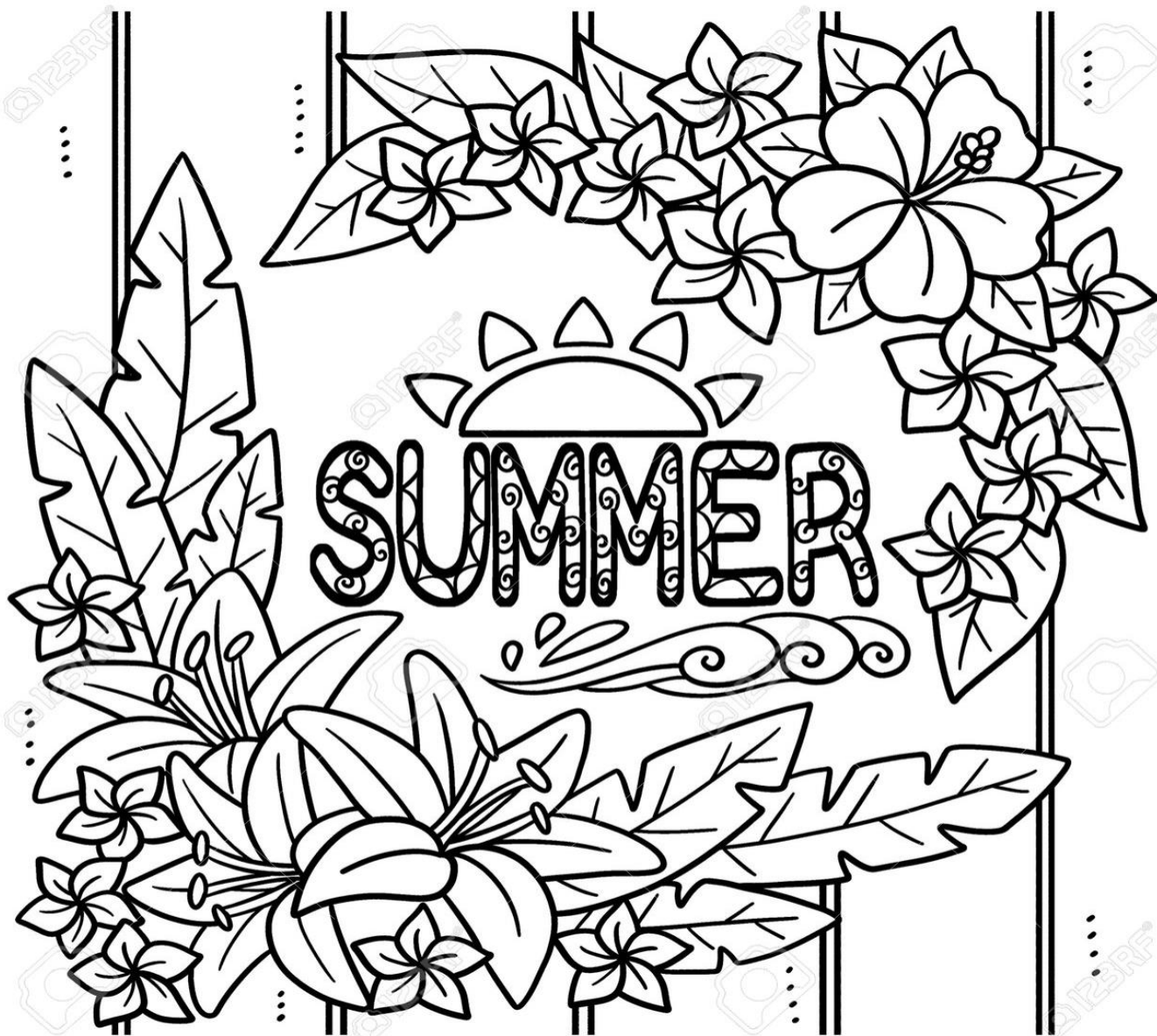

- * Concept: Understanding bird migration patterns and reasons.

- * A large world map or a regional map.

- * Small bird cutouts (different species).

- * String or yarn.

- * Push pins or small magnets.
- * Optional: Display board or poster board.
- * Procedure:
 - * Pin or magnet the bird cutouts to their starting locations on the map.
 - * Use string or yarn to represent migration routes, connecting the starting locations to the birds' wintering grounds.
 - * Label the birds, their starting locations, wintering grounds, and reasons for migration (e.g., food, climate).
 - * You can add arrows to the string to show the direction of travel.
